The Last Will and Testament of Thomas Blagg being in perfect
sense and memory in the name of God Amen first I bequeath my soul to
God who is my Creator and trust will be my saviour next my body
to the earth with Christian burial as for my personal estate I do
followeth Inprimis I do leave my well beloved wife whose Executors
and my personal estate I do will and bequeath to be equally between
my two sons Ralph Blagg and Thomas Blagg and well beloved wife
Anne Blagg during her widowhood, secondly it is my will and Testament
that my wife shall enjoy the plantation that she now liveth on dur-
-ing her life, and Thirdly it is my will that if in Case my wife should
marry before my Children come to age, that then my whole personal
estate be divided equally, my wife, to have her third, fourthly it is
my will that in Case any of my Children should dye then the survi-
-vor to enjoy his part but in Case they both should dye, then to return
to my well beloved wife, fifthly I do bequeath my plantation at
Machoduck between my two Children and lastly it is my last will
and Testament that Thomas Neutter, Thomas Johnston, Thomas Tennent
and John Shallice to be justices in trust to see this my last will and
Testament performed and to aid and assist her according to the true
intent and meaning hereof and to this my last will and Testament
I have Inevitably set my hand this 3rd of August 1661.
