dom of heavens my body I give to the earth if I die upon land otherwise
where it shall please God to Call for me being now bound to me for my
worldly estate which God in his mercy hath blessed me withall, I give
and bequeath as following —

gave her no more then what the law would give her the said
Mr Fooke answered he would give her no more then what the law
would give her and further this deponent saith not.

Fooke } Fooke of the County of Westmoreland in Virginia Gentlemen and
Thomas Fooke of the same Gentlemen doe agree each with other
that there be a mateship and copartnership between us from the
day of the date hereof till seven years be fully completed and
ended of all our personal and real estate whatsoever within the
Colony of Virginia aforesaid always provided that if the said Mr
Gerrard Fooke and Mr Thomas Fooke shall both agree and be willing
hereunto that this mateship and copartnership shall be void soone
to all intents and purposes In Witness whereof we the aforesaid
Gerrard Fooke and Thomas Fooke have hereunto interchangeably set
our hands and Seals this 12th day of May 1663.
