} In the name of God amen the last will and Testament
of Thomas Johnston being in very weak conditions but in perfect
sense and memory praised be God, I first commit my soul to God
in Jesus Christ who was my creator and redeemer in whom I trust
to be my saviour to raise me again at the last day in Glory, I solemnly
commit my body to the Earth from whence it has its first being
to be decently and orderly buried, and my worldly goods as
followeth, Inprimis I give and bequeath unto my loving wife
Joanna Johnston, all my whole personal estate, leaving they
said wife my whole Executrix over all and every part of the same
only requesting that my said Executrix to give and deliver unto
my Countryman Peter Pitts eldest daughter one half of the
first halving after my decease giving and leaving every part
of the rest of my estate to my aforesaid wife and heirs and to the
my last will and Testament, I have set my hand and seal
the 11th day of February 1665.
