Edmund Bunt I give six fifteenths and to my daughter Katharine Bunt
I give four fifteenths and in Case that either of my said Children dye before
they come to age then I give the said dying Childs part to the Child surviving
and of this my last will and Testament I declare and appoint my above named
loving wife Rebecca Bunt my sole Executrix whom likewise I appoint
Guardian of my said Children dated March the 26th 1658.

in body contrary to my former health Yet of sound and perfect memory
praised be god do here make my last will and Testament in manner
and form as followeth, First I bequeath my soul into the hands
of Almighty God my Creator hoping through the merits of his son Jesus
Christ to have pardon and remission of all my sins that I bequeath
my body to the Earth from whence it came there to be decently
buried and for my worldly estate I give and bequeath as followeth

First I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Elizabeth Munn my plantation
 I now live with all privileges and Appurtenances therunto belonging during her natural
 life and after her decease I doe give and bequeath the same unto my daughter Elizabeth
 Munn to her and her heirs forever I then I doe give and bequeath unto my said wife
 and daughter (after my debts are satisfied all the remainder of my estate between them I
 doe hereby constitute and appoint my said loving wife my sole executrix of this will
 then I doe appoint her overseer and Guardian unto my aforesaid daughter until she come
 to the age of one and twenty years and if it please God my said wife die before my said
 daughter comes to age or be married I doe devise and hereby appoint my loving friend
 George Will to be overseer of my said daughter and her estate until she shall come
 to the age aforesaid or be married In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this
 24th day of April 1659.
