doe make this my last will and Testament in form following Ver:
Imprimis I give and bequeath my soul into the hands of god

my ~~soul~~ ^{and} above saviour Jesus Christ and my body to the earth
decidly to be buried at the direction of my Executors hereafter
named, I Item I give my estate real and personal both of lands
goods, cattle and chattels and debts to my dear and loving wife
Mrs Frances Payton my who I ordaine nominate and appoint my
sole Executrix, except the legacies hereafter mentioned, I Item I give
unto my son in law Thomas Spoke one two Year old mare and
four cows with their increase for the future to be delivered him
when he comes to the age of twenty one, I Item I leave my
father in law Thomas Esq: and Mr Robert Sligh both
of Maryland Overseers to be this my last will performed, In
