Testament, revoking all former Wills by me made, I bequeath my Soul unto
the hand of Almighty God who gave it, firmly hoping & believing that for his
merits & of Jesus Christ my sins are pardoned, and that for his sake I
shall be received into Mercy; I bequeath my body to the Earth from whence
it was taken, and for what worldly Estate I have, I give unto my loving
wife Margarett Blagg to be disposed at her discretion, appointing her my
executrix In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal, June the 4th
Day anno 1694

At a Court held for the said County the 31st day of March 1697
The last Will and Testament of Mr Abraham Blagg deceased, was this
