Sound and perfect memory, doe ordain Constitute and Appoint this to be my last Will
and Testament in manner and form following, I Imprimes I committe my Soul to
God that gave it hoping through the only merits of my Saviour Jesus Christ to
Obtaine Remission of all my Sins, and a resurrection to everlasting light, and my body
to the Ground to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executor hereafter named
and as for my worldly goods which it hath pleased God to lend me I bequath as
fooll. Item I give and bequath unto my dear and loving Wife Ellenor Harris
the Plantation whereon I now live and so much Land adjoining as may contain
50 Acres with all the houses thereon during her life, and after her death to my
Son Arthur Harris and the heirs of his body lawfully begotten, and for
want of such Issue unto my Son William Harris and his heirs forever, Item
I give unto my Son William Harris Fifty Acres; the remaining part of my
Land, lying near John Belys Land, to him my said Son William and the heirs
of his body lawfully begotten, and for want of such heirs then I give the said
Land to my Son Arthur Harris and his heirs forever, Item I give unto my
Son William Harris all my Coopers Tools & Carpenters Tools and my Gun
to him and his heirs forever, Item I give unto my Daughter Anne Harris
One heifer with Calf, or a Calf by her side, to be paid unto of my said
Daughter at the day of her Marriage, Item I give and bequath unto my loving
Wife Ellenor Harris all the residue of my Personal Estate whatsoever &
doe make my said Wife Ex^{or} of this my last Will and Testament, In
Witness whereof I have set my hand and Seal the 14th day of January
1697.

unto God for it do now make my last Will and Testament, I doe leave my
Wife hole and sole Executrix of my Estate to Elizabeth Gordon unto she
and her heirs or Assigns, and I doe give unto my Son in Law Valentine
Harris, 300 Acres of Land lying on the Westernmost side of John Hollis
which I now live upon, to him his heirs Executors Admons or Assigns forever
but if my Son in Law does die without Issue I doe give the Land unto my
Wife, Elizabeth Gordon, to shepher her heirs and Assigns forever, and if I doe
give unto my Son in Law Valentine Harris one Mair Colt which is now
suckling with all her Increase to him or his heirs or Assigns and one
gunn which was his Fathers, and I doe give unto my Son in Law Valentine
Harris one P^{er} Cow called Rose and her calf with all their Increase to
him or his heirs or Assigns, and I doe give unto William Smoot a Sorrell
Horse Colt which is now running with my bay mare, to him or his heirs
or Assigns, and if Thomas Hords Child George Hord does live untill he is
Eight years old I doe leave
