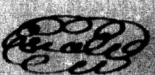


In The Name of God Amen the 2^d Day of December in the year of our
Lord 1697, I Jeremiah Sadwin of Yuccamoco in the County of Westmoreland
being Sick and weak of Body but of Perfect strength of Memory, blessed be
Almighty God for it, and rating to memory the uncertainty of this State of life
and that all flesh must yield unto Death, when it shall please God to call
me make Constitute and Declare this my last Will and Testament in
Manner and form following, revoking and annulling by these presents, all and
every testament of Testaments, Will and Wills heretofore made by me or Declared
either by word or writing of this to be taken only for my last Will of Testament
and none other, First being penitent and Sorry from the Bottom of my Heart
for my manifold transgressions and Sins Past, most humbly desiring forgiveness
for the same, I give and bequeath my Soul to Almighty God my Saviour, in
whom and by the Merits of Jesus Christ and I trust and believe assuredly to
be saved, and to have a full remission of forgiveness of all my Sins and that
my Soul with my body at the General Day of Resurrection shall rise again
with joy and through the Merits of Christs Death and Passion possess and
Inherit the Kingdom of heaven prepared for his Elect and Chosen; and my
Body to be buried in such place and manner as it shall please my Executors
hereafter named to appoint, and now for the settling of my Temporal Estate
and such Goods, Chattels, Relicks as it hath pleased God far above my deserts
to bestow upon me, I do ordain give and dispose in manner and form following
I will and bequeath unto my Cousin Jeremiah Sadwin the son of,

Bartholomew Jasswin, the Son of John Jasswin, to him he has been as heirs
 and Heirs forever, all my lands situate lying and being in your county such, at the
 age of 21 years; Item I will and devise my well beloved Friend John Tanner, that he
 may be my full and whole Executor of this my last Will and Testament and
 that he have my dwelling house and his Commodities thereout of the said
 Land during his natural life; Item I give and bequeath to Deborah Henshaw
 Ten Thousand pounds of Tobacco being her due at her day of Marriage over and
 above her due, from her father's Will; Item I give and bequeath to my God Daughter
 Dorcas Spence, the Daughter of Alexander Spence, One two years old kinsman to
 be delivered after my decease; Item I give and bequeath to my God Daughter
 Anne Payne the Daughter of William Payne of your county rich my Mulatto
 Girl called Moll, for and during the Term and time of Twenty years next after
 my decease, and then at the Expiration of the said Twenty years the said Mulatto
 Moll shall be clearly and absolutely free and clear, from her, and all other
 Services whatsoever; Item I will and bequeath to my Mulatto Man Roach
 his Wife and Child be Absolutely and clearly all free Immediately after my decease
 Item I give and bequeath unto my well beloved friend Richard Bond Twenty pounds Sterg
 to be paid on Demand after my decease, Item I will that my Mulatto Tom be sell
 free and clear at the age of 21 years, Item I will and devise that my Executors
 before named, John Tanner, do well and truly Satisfy and pay all my Debts of
 duties which in right or Conscience I owe unto any manner of Person or
 persons whatsoever within convenient time after my decease, without trouble

Percas Spence, the Daughter of Alexander Spence, One two years old heifer to
be delivered after my decease; Item I give and bequeath to my God Daughter
Anne Payne the Daughter of William Payne of Ypscomoco with my Mulatto
Girl called Moll, for and during the Term and time of Twenty years next after
my decease; and then at the Expiration of the said Twenty years the said Mulatto
Moll shall be clearly and absolutely free and clear, from her, and all other
Service whatsoever; Item I will and bequeath to my Mulatto Man Rosco of
his Wife and Child be absolutely and clearly set free Immediately after my decease
Item I give & bequeath unto my well beloved friend Richard Bond Twenty pounds Sterling
to be paid on Demand after my decease; Item I will that my Mulatto Tom be set
free and clear at the age of 31 years; Item I will and desire that my Executors
before named, John Tanner, do well and truly Satisfy and pay all my Debts &
duties which in right or Conscience I owe unto any manner of Person or
persons whatsoever within convenient time after my decease, without trouble
or Suit of the Law, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
Seal the Day and year above Written
