

In The Name of God Amen the tenth day of January 1697 I John Carrier of Cople Parish in Westmoreland County in the Dominion of Virginia being of perfect memory and Remembrance praised be god, doe make & Ordaine this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following, first Openly I bequeath my Soul into the hands of Almighty God my maker, hoping that thro: the Meritorious death and passion of Iesus Christ my only Saviour and Redeemer, to Receive free pardon and forgiveness of all my Sins, and as for my Body, to be buried in Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors hereafter nominated, and as for my worldly Estate, I Dispose of it as followeth I give and bequeath unto my loving Wife Elizabeth Carrier all my whole Estate whatsoever and wheresoever, that is to me belonging, and for as much as there is an agreement, between me and my Father in Law W. Joseph Hardwick for 200 Acres of Land, as may more at large appear by an Instrument of Writing under our hands and seals in the custody of W Benjamin Blanchflower; my Will and Desire is that the said Land may be conveyed to my loving Wife and her heirs forever, In the same manner as it was to be done to me; or otherwise my Father in Law to pay her the said Ten Thousand pounds of Tobacco, which ^{he} was to have for the said Land, of my Estate in his own hands; I make my loving Wife Elizabeth Carrier my Sole Executrix, she paying my Just Dittie, In Witness whereof I set my hand and Seal the day and year above written

and none other, First being penitent and Sorry from the Bottom of my Heart

for the same
