Westmoreland County, being Sick of body, but of perfect memory and mind, praise be
given to the Almighty God, for ever good causes - doe hereunto make good and true
my last Will and Testament in manner as followeth first I commend my Soul
unto the hands of Almighty God, hoping through the Merits of Jesus Christ, to have
full pardon for all my sins, and to inherit eternal life, and my body I commit to
the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors; And concerning all such
worldly and Temporal Estate as it hath pleased God Almighty to bestow upon me I
give and dispose as followeth, Item I give unto Robert Valthes & Sarah Elliotts
all my Estate real and personal in the Kingdom of England, lying in Bromingham
in Warwickshire forever; Item I give and bequeath my Water mill to James Valthes
and John Elliott junr. forever, Item I give my Plantation at the head of Popes Creek
unto Susannah Comocke; Item I give unto Elizabeth Valthes my Plantation in
Essex County; Item I give unto James Valthes my houses and Furniture, Item I
give unto Mary Elliott my Mare; and Colt to Martha Elliott; & further I do
appoint my loving Brother Caleb Butler to be my whole and sole Executor of this
my last Will and Testament, and I do hereby revoke and disannule and make void
all former Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made, as Witness my hand this 16th
day of February. 1697.
