

In The Name of God Amen the 15th day of March 1697 I John Hawking of Washington Parish in the County of Westmoreland being sick and weak of body but of perfect sound mind & memory, thank be therfor given to God herefor calling to mind the Mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all once to die doe make and ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner and form following, first and principally I give my soul to god who gave it me, and for my body I command it to the earth, to be buried in Christian & decent manner, as to my executors hereafter named shall be thought meet and convenient, nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of god, and as Touching such worldly Estate, wherewithal it hath pleased god in his life to blesse me with I give & devise, bequeath & dispose the same in manner & form following, Item I give unto my god Daughter Margarett Hewellin one Red heifer, about two years old, marked flower belue on the right t' a crop & two stites on the left, with all her increase, Item I give unto Samuer Abbington my new Kersey Coat & hat and Leather breeches, Item it is my Will that all the rest of my Estate be sold at an outcry, and Tobacco to be made of it & the said Tobacco equally divided (after all persons are satisfied) between my two Sons William Hewelin and Thomas Hewelin at the full age of sixteen, & if either of them die before the time, the survivor to have his part, Item I desire that my two Sons be brought up in the fear of god and to read Prophetic English Item It is my Will that if my two Sons should die before they come to full age of sixteen, that then what Tobacco there shall be remaining to my two Sons;

above. Whereas, Now I will that Lawrence Washington be my full & sole Executor of
th. my last Will & Testament and I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke & annul
all and every other former testaments Will, legacies or Executors by me in any time
before this time named, witness & bequeathed, ratifying & confirming his and none other to
be my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and fixed my Seal the day and year above specified; One legacy further
my will & pleasure is, that my Son William Huelin have my gun, and that she
be new stocked, as soon as convenient to serve.
