On the Name of God. amen January 1st 1695 I John Jones of Washington
Parish in Westmoreland County in the Colony of Virginia (Planter) being sick & weak
in body but of sound and perfect memory Praised be given unto God for the same
and knowing the uncertainty of his life on Earth and being desirous to settle things
in order do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following
that is to say first and principally I commend my soul to almighty god my
Creator affirmying believing that I shall receive full Pardon & free remission of
my sins and to be saved by the precious death & merits of my blessed Saviour
and redeemer Jesus Christ and my body to the earth ~~to be~~ from whence it was
taken; to be buried in a decent Christian manner, and as touching such worldly
Estate as the Lord in Mercy hath sent me, my will and meaning is that the same
shall be employed and bestowed as hereafter by this my Will is expressed, and first I
revoke, renounce and make Void all wills by one formerly made, and declare this to
be my last Will and Testament. Then I give and bequeath unto my Son after
Jones a Child Part of the Plantation and Lands I now live upon after he comes to
the full age of 18, to occupy for his own use as he thinks fit and after his mothers
decease, then to enjoy it wholly his selfe to him and his heirs lawfully begotten
forever, but if in case he dies without lawfull issue begotten by his body, then

for it to fall to my Daughter Elizabeth Jones to her and her heirs forever Item
my Will and Desires is for my two Sons, Manwaring Jones and John Jones for to live with
their mother in Law Mary Jones as long as she keeps herself unmarried or till they
both come to full age of Twenty years, but if in case she marries before they come
to the age of 20 years my will and Desires is for them to be under the Tuition of Mr.
Thomas Arrowsmith without they think fit to live with their mother in Law, Then I give
and bequeath unto my above mentioned wife Mary Jones all my Pofanall Estate also
I give and bequeath unto my Wife Mary Jones all the plates which now belongs unto
me Item my Will and Desires is for my wife Mary Jones should be my whole & Real
Execution, At witness my hands and Seal this 4th Day of January 1695
