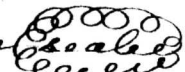


April the 3rd 1698

 Stamp Linnen, and one pair of yarne Stockings, To the said John Bell
 one pair of Shoes and woole Stockings, and for what is Else I leave
 Richard Bradunch whole and sole Executor
