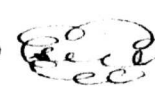


Now all men by these presents that James Westcomb CWC

Inventory of the Goods and Chattels of ~~Arrowsmith~~ Property belonging
to the Orphans of Richard Arrowsmith late of Washington Parish in Westmo-
reland County in Virginia which Estate is to be made good to the said Orphans
when it comes due to him by his Fathers Will, by Thomas Rufel, who married
the Widow and Executrix of the said Arrowsmith for the performance of which
William Horton became Security with the said Thomas. Rufel 2nd May 1690
Imprimis two good Cows with Calf or Calves by their sides, between the age
of Four and Six years old, two yearling heifers, one yearling Bull one two years
old Steer, and one two years old bull, one good Saddle horse, between the age
of four and Six years old, one good breeding Mair, between the age of Three and
Seven year old, four breeding Sows with, Pigs or Piggs by their side, bred on the
said Arrowsmiths Plantation, two good Barrows about four years old and four
Shoats about two or Three months old, one middle size Sucker Dish and two
small @lts, One good Shag rug, and a pair of good blankets, a good middle
size Iron Pot and a Fryng Pan, one good Chest with a lock & Key, and a Gun

fixed and Twelve hundred pounds of good legal Tobacco and Cask to be paid conveniently in the Parish aforesaid

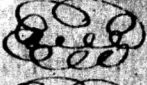

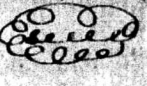

Russell of Washington Parish in Westmoreland County in Virginia Planter and William Horton of the Parish aforesaid, Gentleman, And do owe and stand Justly Indebted to the Orphans of Richard Arrowsmith Late of the Parish and County aforesaid the full and Just Quantity of Twenty thousand pounds of good legal Tobacco and Cask to the true Payment whereof well and Truly to be made to the said Orphans or whom of Right it shall belong by the last Will and Testament of the said Richard Arrowsmith when due we do Oblige ourselves, our heirs, Exors, jointly and Severally firmly by these presents In Witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this 5th day May 1690. The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Thomas Russel shall well and Truly deliver or cause to be delivered to the aforesaid Orphans, or whom of Right it shall belong, all and Singular the foregoing good Chattels, according to the true intent and meaning thereof and pay the said Twelve Hundred pounds of Tobacco then this Obligation to be void or else to stand In full power, force and Virtue
