William Horton became Security with the said Thomas Rufel 2<sup>d</sup> May 1690  
Imprimis two good Cows with Calf or Calves by their sides, between the age  
of Four and Six years old, two yearling heifers, one yearling Bull one two years  
old Steer, and one two years old bull, one good Saddle horse, between the age  
of four and Six years old, one good breeding Mair, between the age of Three and  
Seven year old, four breeding Sows with, Pigs or Jiggs by their side, bred on the

ourselves, our heirs, Exors, jointly and Severally firmly by these presents In Witnes  
whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this 5<sup>th</sup> day May 1690. The Con-  
dition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Thomas Russel shall  
well and Truly deliver or cause to be delivered to the aforesaid Orphans, or whom of  
Right it shall belong, all and Singular the foregoing goods & Chattels, according to the  
true intent and meaning thereof and pay the said Twelve Hundred pounds of Tobacco  
then this Obligation to be void or else to stand In full power, force and Virtue
