next ensuing the date and if this be a Guel, then my Son to have two Shares
and to give unto his Sister at 16 years of Age or Marriage Three young heifers
and of this my last Will and Testament I leave my beloved Wife and my beloved
Friend John Luessenbury my Executors to see this my last Will and Testament performed
as Witness my hand and Seal this 17th day of February 1688
