 of the one Part and Joanna King widow of Youcomore in the aforesaid Parish
 and County of the other Part Witnesseth that the said Mary Franklin for and
 in Consideration of the Sum of 1000 Pounds good sound Merchantable Tobacco
 and Caske to her in hand Paid by the said Joanna King, the receipt whereof she
 doth hereby Acknowledge, hath granted bargained and Sold and by these Presents
 doth grant, bargain and Sell unto the said Joanna King all that her Dower
 and Title of Dower or Thirds at the common Law of in and to all that 200 Acres
 of Land, situate lying and being in Youcomore aforesaid now in the Possession
 of the said Joanna and heretofore Escheated by the said Edward Franklin and
 Gillman, and by them Conveyed to Robert King died late husband of the said
 Joanna and all houses, out houses, Orchards, Gardens &c. thereon erected, built &c.
