Item I give to Sarah Tabat all my Wifes Cloaths, Linnen and woollen, shoes and Stockings; Item I give unto my Master Henry Nose, all the Residue of my eldest Estate, and so make my said loving Master Henry Nose my Executor of this my Will and Testament In Witness whereof, I have sett my hand & Seale this 17th Day of January 1697
