In The Name of God amen this 22nd day of June 1698 I Joseph Hardwick of Nomony in the parish of Cople in the County of Westmoreland, being very sick and weak in body, of sound & perfect memory & duly considering the uncertainty of Mans life doe make this my last Will and Testament in writing hereby revoking & making Void all former wills & Testaments whatsoever, I first & bequeath my Soul into the hands of God Almighty my creator, hoping through the Meritts of my Saviour and Saviour Jesus Christ for a full pardon & Remission of all my Sins & my body to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executor hereafter named; Item my Will and desire is that all my Just Debts be honestly paid; Item I give & bequeath unto Sarah Clark my House Keeper Twenty Thousand pounds of Tobacco, Five Thousand pounds of Tobacco to be paid this Fall and the other Fifteen Thousand pounds of Tobacco the next ensuing year, the Tobacco to remain in the hands of Benjamin Blanchflower my Executor hereafter named & Mr. Robert Sanford Sen^r & to be drawn out from thence at the pleasure of the said Sarah Clarke for her own use Item I give and bequeath to Bennetta Buckley her Mothers Trunk & what Cloaths of her Mothers shall be found in it at my death & three Thousand pounds of Tobacco
