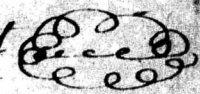

In The Name of God amen so be it, I William Rust being sick and weak of body but of Perfect understanding and memory, do give my soul unto God that gave it, my body to be decently buried; as to that worldly estate it hath pleased God to bestow and give unto me, I doe give and dispose as followeth, First I give and bequeath unto my son William Rust, and unto his heirs forever one complete half of all my Estate of Lands, also I give unto my two Daughters Ann Rust & Margarette Rust the other half of my Lands during their natural lives, and if it please God that my aforesaid ~~two~~ Daughters Son William Rust doe Survive my aforesaid two Daughters, then I doe give unto my aforesaid Son William Rust and to his heirs all my estate of Lands forever; but if it shall please God my aforesaid two Daughters Ann and Margarette doe Survive my said Son William and his heirs, then I doe give my estate of Lands unto my two Daughters Ann and Margarette Rust, and unto their heirs forever, Also I doe give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Margarette and my aforesaid Children all my other estate of Goods, Chattels, Movable and unmovables except my Gun, which I do give unto my son William Rust, also I give unto Anne Smith two heifers of five years old each of them, and a mare of four years old to be delivered to the said Anne Smith at the day of her Marriage Also I doe give unto George Eldridge Sands for twenty years to work on where he is now seating, and do appoint George Eldridge Trustee over my Children and estate after the decease of my wife, & willing all other, I doe confirm this my last Will and Testament, As Witness my hand and Seal this

18th day of March 1697

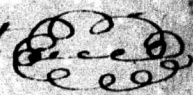
