

In The Name of God amen I Zachariah Hines of the County of
 Westmoreland being at present bound for England, make and addain this my
 last Will and Testament in manner and form following, Inprimes my
 Soul I commend unto God from whom I received it, trusting in his merits
 through my Saviours merits for full pardon of all my Sins, my body
 I likewise to the disposal of the Almighty, and for that worldly Estate
 it hath pleased God to give me, I give and dispose of it as followeth.
 Inprimes I give and bequeth unto my beloved wife Jane the third part
 of my Estate movables and unmovables, for and during the Term of her
 Natural life. Item I give unto Mary Evans daughter of Rebecca
 Hurst and to Simon Come, son of Simon Come, and to Caleb Smith
 Son of Thomas Smith dead, 248 Acres of Land whereon John Handellin
 now liveth to be equally divided between them, the said Mary Evans, Simon
 Come and Caleb Smith, To have and to hold to them, their heirs & assigns
 forever. Item I give William Smith Aephaw son of Humphrey Smith
 100 Acres of Land whereon John King now liveth to have and to hold to
 him the said William Smith his heirs and assigns forever, and it is my
 Will that the profits of the said Lands run for the benefit of the said
 Aephaw William Smith untill he come to age, as also that the stock of
 Cattle upon the said Plantation with their Increase, during the time the said
 King shall live upon the said Land, shall be equally divided betwixt the
 said Aephaw William Smith and John, Son of the said John King and
 if I should die before the said Kings Lease, by which he holds of me be
 expired that he the said King shall have the said Land.

Son of Thomas Smith died, 248 Acres of Land whereon John Handcuttin
now liveth to be equally divided between them, the said Mary Evans, Simon
Come and Caleb Smith, To have and to hold to them, their heirs & assigns
forever Item I give William Smith Apphar Son of Humphrey Smith
100 Acres of Land whereon John King now liveth to have and to hold to
him the said William Smith his heirs and assigns forever, and it is my
Will that the profits of the said Lands run for the benefit of the said
Apphar William Smith untill he come to age, as also that the stock of
Cattle upon the said Plantation with their Increase, during the time the said
King shall live upon the said Land, shall be equally divided betwixt the
said Apphar William Smith and John, Son of the said John King and
if I should die before the said Kings Lease, by which he holds of me be
expired, that he the said King hold the said Land two years longer,
Item my Will is that the Stock upon the plantation that John Hand-
cuttin lives on be divided, that is to say the moiety to the Children of the
said Handcuttin, and the other moiety to the said Mary Evans, Simon Come
and Caleb Smith, all which said Stocks, both here mentioned as also at
the said Kings is to be divided after my said Wife Jane has taken her third
Item I make and ordain William Horton Executor of this my last Will and
Testament, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this
13th day of March 1687.

This Indenture made this 24th of July Anno Dom 1697 & in the ninth year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord King William by the grace of God of England, Scotland, France and Ireland King Defender of the faith &c. Between David Browne of Westmoreland County and Washington Parish of the one Part and John Hore of the same County and Parish of the other part, Witnesseth that whereas Elias Webb late of Westmoreland County deceased by his Last Will & Testament devised a certain tract or parcel of Land in Mutton in the County of Parish above said Joining upon the Land of Mr John Scott and Mr Andrew Monro, containing the one Hundred and Thirty Acres, according to the ancient reputed bounds thereof, and formerly belonged to John Knott of the aforesaid County dead; and being found to Escheat to his Majesty, as by an Inquisition recorded in the
