I give and return my soul to the hands of Almighty God surely trusting in his mercies for a full pardon of all my sins in and through the alone merits of my blessed saviour Jesus Christ and hoping for a joyful resurrection at the last day - my body to the Earth to be decently buried by my Executors hereafter named. I then I give unto my son John Rozier the one half of all my movable Estate - I then I give to my well beloved wife Elizabeth Rozier, the other half of my movable Estate. I then I give unto my beloved wife my dwelling plantation during her natural life. I then I give unto my son John Rozier all my lands, to him and his heirs forever and for my said son to have his whole Estate when it shall please God he come to nineteen years of age. I then I make and appoint my loving wife Elizabeth Executrix of this my last will and testament, making null and void all wills by me formerly made. In witness whereof and in consideration of all and every the within particulars, I have hereunto set my hand and fixt my seal this

this twenty ninth day of January one thousand seven hundred & three.
