These are to certify all whom it may concern that the fifth day of January 1765 came before us the chief officers of her majesties Customs in the Port of Lime Regis, John Hink, master or commander of the ship or vessel called the Speedwell Benthon sixty tons or thereabouts mounted with - - - guns navigated with eight men English built English and produced a cullify - and made oath that at Potomack in Virginia he became bound to her majesties use on or about the thirteenth day of June last with Conditions: That all such sugars, tobaccos, cotton, wool, Indies, Ginger, Huskies, or other dyings, Wood of the growth, production or manufacture of any English plantation in America, Asia, Africa as should be brought or brought the next month
