weak in body but of sound and perfect memory, thanks be to
Almighty God for the same and duly considering the un-
certainty of this life, do make and ordain this to be my
last will and testament in manner & form as followeth -

I commit my soul to almighty God from whom I received
the same, and my body to the earth to be decently interred
according to the discretion of my Executor hereafter named
and for what worldly Estate God in his mercy hath lent
me I give, devise and bequeath the same as followeth
Imp: I give and bequeath unto my son Robert Hard-
wick all my stock of hogs great and small whatso-
ever together with all my woollen wearing apparel to
be delivered to him immediately after my decease.
Item, I give and devise unto my grandson George Hard-
wick son of my said son Robert Hardwick all my stock
of cattle whatsoever, young and old and also my riding
horse saddle and bridle the said cattle to be remain
in the hands of my said Executor until my said grand-
son attain to the age of Eighteen years my said Execu-
tor to have the male increase of the said cattle for
his care to manage the said stock and then to deliver
the same with all their female increase whatsoever
to my said grandson George Hardwick. Item I give
and bequeath unto my said grandson two feather beds
with their furniture, two iron pots to wit my greatest
and my least pots, also six pewter dishes one dozen of
large pewter plates, one pewter flaggon and one iron
spit, one bright brass skillet and eight thousand pounds

me from any person by account or otherwise after my
debts, legacies and funeral expenses paid and satis-
fied all which I will do remain in the hands of my

arrive to the age of Eighteen years. Item - it is my will
