County two young cows and calves to be delivered to them respectively
when they come to their respective ages of twenty one years or mar-
ried that is to say one cow and calf each. Item. I give to Eliz^a
Higgins two sons five shillings each. Item. I give to Mary Triplett
ten shillings money. Item. I give to Original Pope two years schodery
Item. the rest of my estate both real and personal I give to my
wife Jane, I nominate and appoint my loving wife Jane my whole
and sole Executrix of this my last will and testament, revoking
and annulling all other wills and testaments by me before made.
