I give unto my God daughter Mary Walker a young heifer going three years
old. Item I give unto my God son William Graham one young mare foal
which is now sucking of my mare flower as for the remaining part of my
estate I give and bequeath to my loving wife Ann Foster making her wife
and sole Executrix of this my last will and testament, making null and void
all other will or wills by me formerly made. In witness whereof and
in consideration of all and every the within particulars I have here
unto set my hand and fixed my seal this eight day of October, 1700.

In the name of God amen! I William Bonnet of the County of Westmoreland being sick and weak but of sound and in perfect memory thanks be to God for it. I do ordain this my last will and testament, in manner and form as follows. First I give my soul to God that gave it me and my body to be decently buried according to the direction of my Executors hereafter. After all my just debts paid I dispose of all my worldly estate that God hath bestowed upon me in manner as follows. Item - I give unto my eldest daughter Mary my plantation that I call little Dicks with the land belonging to it that is to say all of that side of a deep branch that parts the plantation I live of, and that to her & her heirs forever, and if she should die without issue that then to fall to my son Forcomb, and his heirs forever. I give my daughter also four head of cattle to her and her heirs forever. Item - I give unto my daughter Margrett four head of cattle, two cows, two heifers of three year old. I give her also two better dishes, six plates, one iron pot, one feather bed, one rug, one pair new blankets, one pair of sheets, one son and pig. I give my daughter Margrett my plantation in Stafford forest and all the land belonging to it to her and her heirs forever. If she should die without issue lawfully begotten of her own body that then to fall to my son Forcomb and his heirs forever. I give my daughter Margaret one young gray mare and all her increase forever. Item - I give unto my son in law Christopher one gray mare and purre to him and his heirs forever. Item - I give all
