Item - I give and bequeath unto my well beloved friend Lewis Markham all my goods moveable & immovable in Virgⁿ for the use of my wife Mary Knoble and my three younges children of whom in the County of Dorsetshire - I do constitute, ordain and appoint my trusty and well beloued the abm said Lewis Markham my sole Executor of this my last will & testament, revoking and annulling all former wills or wills testaments and testaments heretofore by me made either by word or writing in Virginia.
