of perfect memory and understanding do make this my last will
and testament in manner and form following, In witness I give
bequeath my Soul to God who gave it hoping through the merits of my
Savior Jesus Christ it shall at the last day be reunited to my body
and glorified, and I bequeath my body to the grave to be decently
buried at the discretion of my Executors thereafter named and as

for what estate it has pleased God above my deserts to bestow upon me
I give and bequeath in manner following. Item I give and bequeath
to my daughter Rebecca Telson sixty acres of land of which I lately
bought of John Williams the Elder the said land I give to my said
daughter Rebecca and her heirs forever, she my said daughter to be
possessed with the said land at the age of eighteen or day of marriage
which shall first happen. Item I give to my son Robert Telson all
the remainder of my land that is to say by computation seventy acres
the which land I give to my said son and his heirs forever. Item
I give to my son Robert my gun and sword. Item I give to my
wife Hannah Telson two iron pots one brass kettle, one flesh fork,
ladle and skimmer and one large spit. Item I give to my wife one
feather bed and furniture the best I have. Item I give my wife
