I promise I give bequeath my soul to God who gave it hoping through the merits of my Savior Jesus Christ it shall at the last day be recompensed to my body and glorified, and I bequeath my body to the grave to be decently buried at the discretion of my Churc'h thereafte named and as

for what estate it has pleased God above my deserts to bestow upon me
I give and bequeath in manner following - Item I give and bequeath
