Now know ye that the said James Orchard for divers good causes me thereunto moving and more especially for a valuable quantity of seven thousand five hundred pounds of tobacco and other valuable considerations by me in hand received and wherewith I acknowledge myself fully satisfied & contented and paid him bargained, sold, given, granted, aliened, enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do bargain, sell, give, grant, alien, enfeoff and confirm unto John Ware of the County aforesaid a certain tract or parcel of land containing two hundred and fifty
