saviour, Jesus Christ, and my body to be buried at the dis-
cretion of my Executor hereafter named and for my tempor-
al Estate which it hath pleased God to bless me withall
I give as followeth. Imprimis. I give and bequeath unto
my loving friend Richard Mather all my lands, chattels,
tobacco and money to him and his heirs. I likewise
appoint my loving friend Richard Mather Executor of this
my last will and testament and I do further revoke
abandon and make void all other wills by me formerly made
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this 17th day of September 1701.
