I, Thomas Wilford of Washington Parish in Westmoreland County Virg^a Gen^b being weak of body, but of perfect sense and memory, praised be God for it do make, constitute and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following (W^y) first, I bequeath my soul to God who gave it me, hoping at the last day receive joyful resurrection in my Lord and saviour Jesus Christ and my body to be buried at the discretion of my Executor hereafter named and for my tempor^able Estate which it hath pleased God to blesse me withall I give as followeth. Imprimis. I give and bequeath unto my loving friend Richard Watts all my lands, chattels, tobacco and money to him and his heirs. I likewise appoint my loving friend Richard Watts Executor of this my last will and testament and I do further revoke abanneled and make void all other wills by me formerly made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 17th day of September 1708.
