Nuncupation will have hereunto set their hands this one and thirtieth
day of March 1703. John Rice, Bridget Smith.

nulling by these presents all and every testament and testaments
Will and Wills heretofore by me made and declared either by word
or writing notwithstanding any promise to the contrary or clause derogat-
