 out of it, do make, constitute, ordain and appoint this my last will and
 testament in manner and form following (viz^t) First, I give my soul into the
 hands of Almighty God, hoping by the mediation of my blessed saviour Jesus
 Christ, to receive it again at the resurrection of the dead; my body I
 give to the earth to be decently buried. And for my worldly goods I dis-
 pose, will and bequeath as followeth. Item - I give and bequeath unto
 my loving brother Francis Atwell my best feather bed, bolster & furniture there-
 unto belonging to him and his heirs forever. Item - I give and bequeath unto
 my loving brother John Atwell my best riding horse, with bridle & saddle
 pistols, holsters, furniture thereunto belonging, my sword and belt and
 cane with all my wearing apparel of what kind soever as coats & other
 things unto him his heirs & assigns forever. Item - all the rest of my
 estate, real and personal as land and house hold stuff, cattle, sheep
 horses, mares, hogs and whatever else I am now possessed of give and
