the County of Westmoreland: widow, being now my self
and weak of body, but of perfect mind and memory
thanks be given unto God I do make and ordain
this my last will and testament in manner & form
foll: That is to say first and chiefly I give my
soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it
me and my body I commend to the Earth to be de-
cently buried and in Christian burial at the exec-
ution of my Executrix, nothing doubting but at
the general resurrection I shall receive the same
again by the mighty power of God. As touching my
worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to ble-
me, I give, devise, bequeath and dispose of the same
in manner and form following. Item I give to my
daughter Ely Cochran all my right and title to the
plantation I now live on in the above p[arish] & County
to her and her heirs forever, also I give her six
cows two two year old and three calves now belong-
ing to me on the said plantation, also I give my

said daughter Elizabeth all my hogs that are now on the said plantation marked with a crop on the right ear and an unbroken and another mark on the left ear to be delivered to her or some man and to be now in her possession - Item I give my said daughter Elizabeth 4 pair of sheets 1:8 1 pair of holland sheets and 3 pair of canvas sheets to be now in her possession also four deeper napkins and one holland table cloath and four pewter dishes and one Doy. of flasks two tankards a little basin of porring and six porringers and one Doy. of new spoons and three salt sellers and two chests with the locks & keys to them Item I give my said daughter my bed I lay by and the furniture thereto belonging also I give her three iron pots and four hooks to them with links to hang them on also a pail and a pegow, one brass candlestick and two tables 1:8 a black walnut table and a poplar table and a brass skillet, two bedsteads of joyners work a new bolster case and three feather pillows Item I give my said Daughter Eliz. all other steers or cows or calves that are of the mark on my hogs within named that are now in my possession or can be found on my possession the said plantation or elsewhere Item I give my said daughter a sixty gallon cask of rye setting syder or all that now remains in it part being drunk - also I give her one anchor and a five gallon cask now in my possession. Also I give her a crop cut saw two hand saws Item I give my said daughter Elizabeth all the horses and mares that I now have and particularly I give her the mare aks to be now in her possession with the side saddle and furniture belonging Item I give her a small feather bed and three blankets and two rugs and one bolster - Also I give her a drawing knife. Item I give my said daughter Elizabeth all my right and title to all my written or unwritten bills and accounts that I have now in my eas.

three feather pillows. Item. I give my said daughter Ely. all
other Stears or coms or calves that are of the mark on my
hogs within named that are now on my possession or can be

resettling syder or ale that now remains in it part
being drunk. Also I give her one anchor and a five
gallon cask now in my possession. Also I give her a
crop cut saw, two hand saws. Item I give my said daugh-
ter Elizabeth all the horses and mares that I now have
and particularly I give her the mare oaks to be now in
her possession with the sese saddle and furniture belong-
ing. Item. I give her a small feather bed and three
blankets and two rugs and one bolster. Also I give
her a drawing knife. Item. I give my said daughter
Elizabeth all my right and title to all my written or un-
written bills and accounts that I have now in my pos-
session and is upon any score due to me in Virginia to
be duly paid to her or her order her heirs or assigns
Item. I give unto my said daughter Ely one piece of
black stuff now in my chest and six yards of very ad
one ell of serge and all my linew that I now have
and all my cloathes made or unmade. Also I give her
my grindstone that now is on the above plantation
and two reap hooks. Item. I give to my daughter
Ely: a debt that is due to me on account from John
Franklin of the said parish of Washington planter to

will, in tobaccoes by his own acknowledgement seven hundred
and Eighty pounds of tobaccoe to be paid on demand or her
or her order. Item I give to my said daughter Eliz. thirteen
quart bottles and two earthen porringeres and two earthen
plates and the meat barrel and all other lumber goods
of what kind ever that now is in my possession. Also
I give her a set of maps now in my possession. Item
I give unto my said daughter Eliz. all the corn & fodder
that was tended upon my account this year on the said
plantation. Item It is my will that my daughter Eliz.
should be now of age at this present time only I would
not have her make any bargains without advice of her
friends. and of this my last will and testament, I make
my well beloved daughter Eliz. a Cochran aforesaid my full
& whole Executrix. And I do hereby disannul & revoke all
other former testaments, wills and legacies &c. by me made
or bequeathed confirming this and no other to be my last
will and testament. I witness whereof I have here
set my hand and seal the day and year above written.
