 Ireland, Queen, Defender of the faith and in the year of our

 John Baker of the County of Westmore, Taylor, of the one
 party and William Edwards of the same County Planter
 of the other party: Witnesseth, that the said John Ba-
 ker doth by this presents for the consideration of five thou-
 sand pounds of good tobacco in cash already paid by the said
 William Edwards before the signing, sealing and delivering
 of these presents the receipt wherewith the said John Baker
 doth acknowledge himself fully, satisfied, contented and paid
 and doth by this presents acquit, exonerate and forever dis-
 charge the said Wm Edwards his heirs, Executors, Admin^{rs} and
