tween them for them and their heirs to enjoy forever, Item I
do give and bequeath unto my aforesaid son one horse bridle
and saddle Item I do nominate and appoint my loving
wife Many Cole to be my sole Executrix of this my last will
and testament, revoking and annulling all former
wills by me made. As witness my hand and seal this
1st day of February in the year of our Lord God one thousand
and seven hundred and seven.
