Will

In the name of God amen this 16th day of
January 1715 I Anne Smith of the parish of Washington
and County of Westmore being weak in body but of a
Sound and perfect memory blessed be god for the same
and calling to mind the uncertainty of this life here
on earth and being desirous to settle things in order to make
this my last will & testament hereby revoking & making void
all former wills or testaments heretofore by me made & declare
this only to be my last will & testament in manner & form
following that is to say first and principally I give & bequeath
my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it me and
my body to the earth from whence it was first taken to be
Buried in a Christian like and decent burial at the dis-
cretion of my executors hereafter named and as touching such
worldly estate as the Lord of his mercy hath lent me for a
time I Give & bequeath the same in the following like manner
& form I Item I Give to Alice Beekwith one hundred acres
of land during her natural life and after to return to my
generacon I Item I give & bequeath to my daughter in law Mary
Smith all the remainder of my land to her & her lawfull heirs for-
ever I Item my will is that my daughter Mary Smith be
my whole & sole executrix of this my last will & testament
as witness my hand & Seal this 16th day of January 1715

At a court held for the sd County the 30th day of May 1716
The last will & testament of Anne Smith deed was
presented into court by Mary Garrett her executrix who

made oath thereto and being proved by the oaths of both the witnesses thereto is admitted to record and upon motion of the sd Mary & their performing what is usual in such cases certificate is granted her & William Garrett her husband for obtaining a probate thereof in due form
