them to make & give acquittances & other discharges for the same and
also for me & in my name to enter or cause any entry or entries
to be made into & upon all & every the messuages tenements Mills
buildings houses lands and plantations in the 2^d County of Stafford
or in any other County in Virginia aforesaid or else where whereof
or wherein my said late son did & might possess or interfere and are
now belonging unto me & detained from me by any person or persons
whatsoever. And to lett sell & demise all & every such messuages
tenements buildings houses Mills lands & plantations to and for my
most advantage and benefit for any term or terms number or
numbers of years not exceeding seven years at most as to my
said attys shall think meet & expedient. And to take or cause to be
taken any distres or distresses for or by reason of the non payment

for and in consideration of the sum of ten thousand pounds of Silver
to him in hand paid & secured to be paid by the aforesaid John Rush-
rod at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof and every part and parcel thereof he the s^d Robert Smith
doth hereby acknowledge and therefrom doth acquit and discharge
the said John Rushrod his heirs executors & adm^{rs} by these presents
Heath given granted aliened bargained sold enfeoffed and confirmed
and by these presents doth fully clearly & absolutely give grant alien
bargain sell enfeoff & confirm unto the s^d John Rushrod his heirs
& assigns forever all that messuage tenement and tract of land
containing one hundred acres of land being the one half of two
hundred acres lately granted to Henry Dunkan and by the proprietors
of the Northern Neck and by me purchased of Charles Dunkan & Henry
Dunkan it being the Eastermost part of the aforesaid two hundred
acres with all its rights rights members appurtenances together
with all houses buildings orchards gardens lands tenements pastures
hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever to the s^d messuage or ten-
ement belonging or in any wise appertaining all which said
messuage land and premises are situate lying & being within the
parish of Cople & County of Westm^{ts} and now in the tenour and
occupation of the aforesaid Robert Smith and the reversion and reversions
remainder & remainders of all & singular the before mentioned premises
and also all the estate right title interest use possession property
