Lady Fairfax By this Publick Instrument of Procuracion or letter of attorney Be
it knowne and manifest unto all people that on the seventh day of De-
cember anno Domini 1711 and in the tenth yeare of the Reigne of our
Majestie King George the Second and by commandement of our
Sovereign Lady Anne Queen of England & Britaine &c - I Robert Lee
William Scory Notary Publick admitted & sworne dwelling in Lon-
don and the presence of the witnesses aforesaid Personallie appeared
the Honble Catherine Lady Fairfax of Leeds Castle in the County of
Kent relict of the Honble Thomas Lord Fairfax Baron Cameron in
that part of Great Britaine called Scotland which appears in the first
place invoking a procuracion or letter of atty by her owne to Coll. Ro-
bert Carter of Virginia to the following effect. H[ec]c de novo made
ordained & constituted & by these presents doth make ordaine & constitute
Thomas Lee of the County of Westmoreland in Virg^a Merchant her true
& lawfull atty. Giving unto him full power & authority to sue in
the name and to the use of the said constituent to make demand
sue for recover and receive all such quitt rents & arrears of quitt
rents and other summs & sums of money tobaccoes or other effects
as are or shall be due money & belonging to the said constituent
by & from any person or persons whatsoever as she is lady proprietor

of the said County's in the Northern necks in Virg: and touching
the same to account compromised conclude and agree as occasion
shall require. Upon recovery & receipts to make & give due &
sufficient acquittances & discharges. And the said Constituant doth
hereby further impower her said attorney to demand & take into
his possession all papers Debts & writings whatsoever to her belonging
& now in the hands of the said Coll: Carter together with all
sums & values of Money or other effects already received or that
may be received by him in virtue of the power of Atty formerly
granted him and now revoked by the said Constituant as aforesaid
upon receipts to give due discharges. and (if need be) to appear
in any Court or Courts convenient and to pursue & plead such
Sequester attach arrest Imprison and to condemn and out of pris-
on againe (when need shall be) to deliver him facultate substituende
and generally in all concerning the premises and the dependency's
to do say transact & accomplish whatsoever the said Constituant her
self might or could doe personally. She hereby promising to
hold & ratifie her good & valid whatever her said attorney or his
substitutes shall lawfully do or cause to be done in the premises
by virtue of these presents. In witness whereof the said Constitu-
tant hath hereunto set her hand & seal the day and year first
above written.
