7 yards of Shalloon & 2 yards of coarse lining a p<sup>r</sup> of gloves & a pair of shoes & 4 or 5 shottles of powder & shott & 15<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yards of W<sup>g</sup>. Cotton that was at the weavers at his death made use of & not put into the Inventory of old stumps of horses & old axes & ditto & some more of its hides
