Item I will that my whole share of Tobacco in the hands of Mr Thomas Lee in Lancaster County and six hundred besides the whole share & a bill of sixteen hundred pounds of Tobacco due to me by Lawrence Moulle in the hands of Edward Newjen one hundred & seventy pounds of Tobacco in said Newjens hands from James Collier all which Tobaccos I will that the s^d Mr Tho^s Lee & Ed. Newjen pay unto Richard Vandenberg who is by my will my sole executor in trust to take care of my daughter Ann Wilson as witnesses my hand & seal this tenth day of Feby 1713.
