Sorrell Frances Dункan.

At a Court held for the s^d County the 29th day of Sep^r 1714 Dorothy Waters (formerly Dункan) personally acknowledged the within Instrum^t to be her proper act & deed to be & enure to the use & uses within mentioned which Youell Watkins by virtue of a power accepted in behalfe of W^m Maclanacan to & for the uses therein specified ordered the same be recorded.
