In the name of God amen I James Smith of the parish of Cople in the County of Westmore in Virginia being in perfect sense and memory helped by the living God for it do make this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following First I give unto my son James Smith one negro girl called Mall to be delivered him when he shall come to the age of twenty years by my executrix hereafter mentioned I give unto my loving wife Anne Smith the use of two negro men called Sambo and Roger during her natural life and after her decease to return to my son James Smith further my will is that if the negro girl above said should bring three children they shall be delivered to my three daughters Jane Smith, Anne Smith & Eliz^a Smith the first to my daughter Jane the second to my daughter Anne the third to my daughter Elizabeth each child to be delivered at one year old I give my son James Smith the land whereon I now dwell which I bought of Col^d Will^d Liam Pierce and the land I bought of Mr. Ed. Rousby joining to this land to him & his heirs lawfully begotten forever but my will is that if my son Ja. Smith should die without issue that then the said land which I have given him to be equally divided between my three daughters Jane Smith Anne Smith & Eliz^a Smith and their heirs for ever my will is also that the land called timber-neck which I bought of Mr. John Spencer be sold by my executrix for money or tobacco to pay my debts further my will is that all the rest of my estate be equally divided between my wife & four children James Smith Jane Smith Anne Smith & Eliz^a Smith and do appoint my loving wife Anne Smith executrix of this my last Will & Testament further my will is that neither of my daughters Jane Smith Anne Smith & Elizabeth Smith have any part of my estate untill the day

of marriage and my will is that my son James Smith have no part of my estate untill he come to the age of twenty years and now to confirm this my last will & testament I do by these presents make void all former wills by me made and do make this my last will & testament In Witnes whereof I hereunto set my hand & seal this ninth day of December one thousand seven hundred & thirteen
