said Charles Smith & Anne his wife for & in consideration of the
sum of Forty pounds Sterl: have given grant bargained and
sold and do by these presents give grant bargain sell make over re-
move release enfeoff & for ever confirm unto the said Garrett Creaks &
his heirs all that piece or parcels of land situate lying & being in the
County and parish aforesaid containing one hundred & thirty acres
which said land was the proper estate & inheritance of James But-
ler late of the parish & County aforesaid who dying without will
or making any disposition of the same the said one hundred thirty
acres of land came by virtue of escheat to the proprietors of the North
or Neck of Virg^a and the same the mother of the said James But-
ler being in the actual possession of the said land the said land
with the appurtenances was granted to the said Anne party
to these presents as of patent under the hand of Robert Carter eng^r
