said son Youell and his heirs for ever Item I give and bequeath
to my son Samuel Attwell my Plantation wheron I now live being
the remainder of my aforesaid dividend together with the members
& appurtenances unto the same belonging to him my said son Samu-
el & his heirs for ever Item it is my will & meaning that my
whole aforesaid dividend of land shall be equally laid out in three
parts including in each part one of the above mentioned plan-
tations and that each & every of my above named sons enjoy & hold
their parts as above bequeathed together with a third part of my
