In the name of God amen I John Erwin
of the parish of Cople in the County of Westmore being
weak in body but of sound & perfect sense & memory
blessed be god for it doe make ordaine & declare this
to be my last Will & testament in manner & form
following hereby revoking all former Wills &
Testaments by me made dated this 10th day of
Aprill in the second year of the reign of our so-
veraign Lord George of great Brittain France &
Ireland King &c. and in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred & sixteen Imp^{ts} I
Bequeath my soul unto god that gave it me
hoping by his infinite mercy and by my dear
Saviour Jesus Christ his intercession and the merit^s
of his passion it shall at the last day be reunited
to my body & glorified and I will that my body
have Christian burial. I Item it is my Will

that all my Just debts be honestly paid & satisfied
 as soon as conveniently may be after my deceased
 term it is my will & desire that my god children
 hereafter named (to witt) John son of George & Anne
 South Frances daughter of John Torrell & Anne
 his late wife Demimah daughter of John & Man-
 nah Aubrey John son of Frances & Frances Aub-
 rey John son of Charles & Temperance Lucas
 and Elizabeth daughter of Thomas & Elizabeth
 Torrell have two yeares Schooling a peice at such
 time as they respectively shall attaine to yeares of
 discretion to be taught the expence whereof to be
 paid for by my ex^{rs} hereafter named out of my
 estate Item I give & bequeath to William Clark
 my present overseer all my wearing apparrell both
 Linnen & Woollen Item I give & bequeath to my
 friend Mr John Aubrey and to his heirs & assigns
 forever all that my land & appurtenances which I
 purchased from Mr John Nelson late died Item
 I give & bequeath to my friend Thomas Torrell
 and to his heirs & assigns forever all those my
 two plantacons (to witt) that which I purchas-
 ed of Joseph Beale and that which I purchased
 of James Lane both situate in the parish &
 County above said together with their and
 every of their members & appurtenances what-
 soever Item all the rest residue and remainder

of my estate real & personal I give & bequeath
to my aforesaid friends John Aubrey & Thomas
Correll and their heirs & assigns forever equally
to be divided between them and lastly I ap-
point the said John Aubrey and Thomas
Correll executors of this my last will &
testament In testimony whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & Seale the day &
Yeare first within written John Erwin (Seal)
Sealed published and acknowledged by the
said John Erwin in presence of J^{rs} Aub-
brey Joseph Beale Thomas Gray
