In the name of God amen I John Jones of the County of West-
Will. 3m Co being very sick and weak in body but of perfect mind and me-
mory thanks be given unto God therefore calling unto mind the mor-
tality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once
to die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testam^t that is to
say principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul into the
hands of God that gave it, and for my body I commend it to y^e earth
to be buried in an a Christian manner at the discretion of my ex-
ecutors nothing doubting but at the last resurrection I shall receive
the same again by the mighty power of God. and as touching
such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in
this life. I give devise and dispose of the same in the manner and
form following Item I give and bequeath unto my son Nathan-
iel Jones one black mare branded H one Cow and calf a gun two
pewter dishes one son with pigg one basin three plates one fork
to be delivered at a year. Item I give and bequeath to my daughter
Eliz^a Jones a feather bed one iron pot one Cow and calf a Dutch
chest and the first mare colt that Nath^l Jones his mare brings I

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Anne Jones one feather
bed one Chimney and one young mare one trap kettle two fowls such one
large barrel one horn. I give and bequeath unto my son Charles Jones
a Chimney and calf and the first mare Colt my mare being brought
me soon as I give my gun one large fowls barrel one trap kettle. I
tem I give and bequeath unto John Overall son to Wm Overall and
to Wm Overall junior each of them a young heifer. I tem I give and
bequeath unto Mary Overall one young mare. I tem I give and
bequeath to my wife one feather bed and furniture one horse a side
saddle one marning a trap kettle. I tem I give one crown to my
daughter Anne Jones. I do constitute and appoint William Over-
all to be my true & executor of this my last Will and testam^t all
the rest of my estate equally to be divided between my wife and
children and my land I give to be equally divided in quantity that
is to Nath^l Jones and Charles Jones to them and their heirs suc-
cessively for ever and no other Witeⁿes my hand and seal this
tenth day of Jan^y. anno q^uo Domⁱ 1707. It was interlined before as-
