Pratt In the name of God amen I John Pratt of Westmst
 Will County in Virginia being sick & weak of body but of perfect
 sense & memory thanks be giving to almighty God for the same
 & calling to mind the uncertain state of a man daye and
 knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die doth ordaine
 this my last will & testament in manner & form as follows Impe
 I give & bequeath my soul into the hands of almighty God that
 gave it me and my body to the earth from whence it was taken
 trusting in the merites of my blessed Saviour Jesus Christ to have
 a full & free pardon of all my sins and as for all the estate that
 it hath pleased almighty God to bestow upon me in this worlde
 I give & dispose as follows Item I give & bequeath unto my
 grand daughter Margrett Pratt two feather beds & furniture
 two iron potts one doz of pewter dishes one doz of pewter plates
 four brasse candlesticks one choice gelding one side saddle of
 1000 pounds of ^{sterl} and one negroe girl named Jane Item I
 give my 2^d grand daughter Margrett Pratt two hundred ^{sterl}
 sterl to be paid her according to the quality of my estate all the
 afores^d legacies is to be paid her at the age of eighteen or marri
 age Item I give & bequeath unto my grand son John Lovell
 four hundred acres of land as Viz^t the one half of that tract
 call flowersis folly and the remainder of the aforesaid four hundred
 acres to be made up out of my tract next to that quarter to him &
 the heirs of his body for ever but if my said grand son Lovell
 should die without heirs of his own body lawfully begotten that then
 the afores^d lands to fall to my grand daughter Margrett Pratt

& her hires for ever I Item I give unto my d^r grand son John
 Lovell two negroes as George and Sarah and six Cows with
 calves six steares about four yeares old I give him also twenty
 head of hoggs one feather bed with furniture one flock ditto
 with furniture one dozen of pewter dishes one dozen of pewter plates
 ½ doz of pewter porringers two iron potts I give my said grand
 son also them horses & mares as we call his and one gelding
 more and four thousand pounds of Tobacco all the afores^d lega-
 cies to be delivered to my d^r grand son when he shall attaine to
 the full age of twenty one yeares I Item I give & bequeath unto
 my daughter in law M^{rs} Mary Peace two thousand pounds
 of Tobacco for the love and good will I bear to her I Item I give
 and bequeath unto my dear & loving son John Pratt all the
 remains of my estate both in money good lands chattells that
 I now have or shall have in the Colony of Virginia or great
 Brittain to him & his hires for ever I Item I constitute ordaine
 & appoint my deare son John Pratt my whole sole executor
 to execute this my last will & Testament revoking & making void
 all other wills & Testaments as yet before by me made & this and
 no other to be taken held & valued for my last will & Testament
 I Item I will that my grand daughter Margrette Pratt be
 kept at school & maintaine out of my estate according to
 the discrecion of my executors Signed with my hand and sealed
 with seal this twenty day of September one thousand seven
 hundred and fourty in the p^rsence of John Pratt ^{Witness}
