Bagge of Westmorland County ctk. being weak in body but sound
in mind and memory do make & ordain this my last will &
testament in manner & form following Vizt I give & bequeath
my soule to God in hopes of salvation thro' the merited & medi-
ation of Jesus Christ my Saviour and my body to the earth
to be decently buried as my husband shall order and where-
as by articles of marriage made & concluded upon by & between
my aforesaid husband John Bagge & my selfe bearing date
the 19th day of December one thousand seven hundred & eleven
I have resolved the disposall of several negroes goods & chattells
to my disposall after my daughter Jane Butlers portion and
part of the estate of my late husband Caleb Butler of West-
morland County gent: be paid as by the said Articles (relation be-
ing thereunto had) may more at large appear which said no-
groes goods & chattells I do give & bequeath in manner
following ~ Item I give & bequeath unto my son Rob^t Vaile
one mourning ring and the balc. of his bill unpaid in Mr. Ed-
ward Joads hands being about five pounds sterd with other things
sent him Vizt Marles &c ~ Item I order that his silver tankard

to give him when a kettle Mr James Vaulx borrowed to return
 ed, Item I give and bequeath unto Mary the daughter of Ro-
 bert Vaulx and her heirs for ever one Negroe woman named Fannie
 to be delivered her the first day of November next with one few-
 ther bed with pillows sheets blanket rug & curtaines six silver
 spoons of those that are expected from Bristol this spring if they
 come safe to Virgⁿ upon condition the said Robert Vaulx will
 suffer my husband to live on the plantation he now lives on one
 whole year after the time my daughter Jane removes from him
 he the said Bagg paying a reasonable Rent Item I give
 and bequeath to my son John Duddlesone and his heirs forever
 one Negroe man named Prince and one hundred pounds Sterl^l of
 tem I give and bequeath to my daughter Eliz^r Porten two rings
 six Silver spoons of those that are expected from Bristol this
 spring if they come safe to Virgⁿ and five pounds Sterl^l to her
 her heirs for ever Item I give to Mr Dan^r Porten on yng
 of a Guineas price Item I give my daughters Eliz^r & Porten
 & Jane Butler all my worn apparell linnen & woolen to be
 equally divided between them as Mrs. Ann Wayly & Mary Watts
 shall think fitt Item I give my daughter Jane Butler all my
 apparell that come lately from Bristol and one new suite
 of Damask Napkins & table cloth Item I give to my daugh-
 ter Jane Butler one Negroe man named Tony to her & her heirs
 for ever & six men chairs and my emerald ring with ten sparks
 of Diamonds round the emerald Item I give & bequeath to my
 loving husband John Bagg one Negroe woman names Fannie
 to him & his heirs for ever Item I give my said husband all the
 goods & plate (the spoons excepted) & watch that I have sent for
 to Bristol and are expected to come to hand this next spring
 Item I give unto my loving husband John Bagg & his heirs
 for ever all that part of household goods stock & all other goods
 chattells and negroes whatsoever not already given or bequeathed
 in this Will that I had the disposal of by the aforesaid articles
 of marriage dated Decemb^r the 19th 1711, Item I give to James
 the son of Elizabeth Jarvis the wife of John Jarvis one negroe
 child called Christmapp and his heirs for ever to be delivered to

the said James his mother when the said negro shall be three
yeares old and five hundred pounds of Tobacco yearly for four
yeares to be laid out on the said James in schooling as his said
mother shall think fitt and an iron pott frying pan & two penter
basons to be delivered him when he is married of age or goes to house
keeping in his own account I tm. I constitute ordaine & appoint
my loving husband John Bagge sole exec^t of this my last Will
& Testament I tm. It is my ^{will} that Mr Dan^r Portin and Joseph
Weekes do take care that this my will be fully performed and also
settle & adjust all accounts between my husband and my daughter
Jane Hunter In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
& seal this second day of February 1712 Item I give to Willi-
am Mooley sen^r who now living one Turkey Coat vest and
trousers one hat and one pair of shoes & one Shirt yearly dur-
ing his life.
